Formation of New Company – Bury Farm Equestrian Club Ltd

From the 1st February 2012 all competitions held at Bury Farm Equestrian Village will be run by Bury Farm Equestrian Club Ltd.

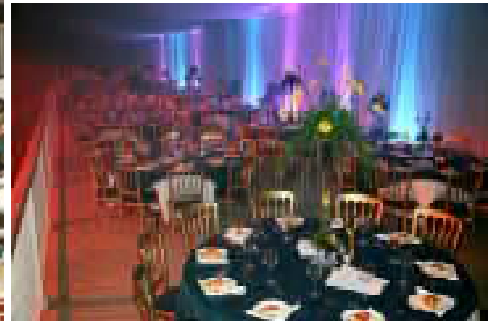
In order to be able to avoid VAT charges to customers it has been decided to transfer the activity of Bury Farm Equestrian Centre Ltd to a new club, Bury Farm Equestrian Club, which will be run by a new company limited by guarantee known as Bury Farm Equestrian Club Ltd. The new club will apply for Community Amateur Sports Club status, which when granted will allow members concessions on VAT.

Users of livery and other facilities at Bury Farm, are invited to become members of the new club with effect from 15th November 2011, and in so doing become members of the new company, **for a lifetime* membership fee of £5**. Non-members will continue to be able to use club facilities but at a 20% higher charge than members, to account for VAT. An application form for membership is available from Reception which should be completed and returned to the club, together with a payment of £5, if you wish to participate in the new scheme. If you do not wish to participate as a member of the new club then please take this as notice that VAT will apply to livery charges with effect from 1st November 2011.

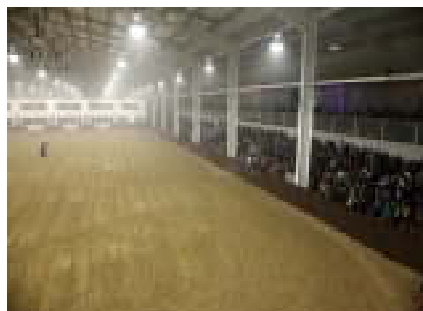
And be wary when listening to your SAT NAV if you want avoid the smaller lanes!!!

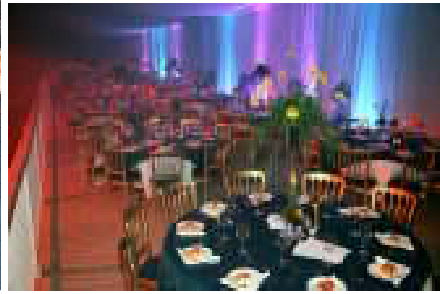

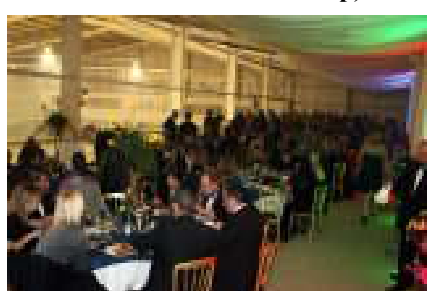

GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. The Show Organiser referred to in these Rules and Regulations shall hereinafter mean Bury Farm Equestrian Club. The Elite Show Jumping Festival will hereinafter be referred to as the Show.
2. All horses must be registered with the British Show Jumping. Unless competing on a Ticket to Ride, this will be charged at £3.
3. The Show, Show Organiser, Volunteer and Officials do not accept liability for any accident, damage, injury, theft or illness to horses, riders, owners, spectators or any other person or property whatsoever.
4. The Show Organiser retains as its absolute discretion the right to decline or exclude or remove any person or animal from the show or future shows or return any entry fee without being required to assign reason or being liable for any compensation.
5. **Competitions** – The Show Organiser reserves the right to cancel, add to, or amend any of the competitions, as they think fit, with the approval of the British Show Jumping.
6. **Smoking** – Smoking is not permitted within any of the showground buildings or stables.
7. **Collecting Ring** – All warming up must be done in the designated Collecting Rings provided. Persons found abusing horses on the showground may be asked to leave.
8. **Refund of Entry and Stable Fees** – Refunds will only be in accordance with British Show Jumping Rule 79.5.1. Any cancellations made after the close of Entry will be charged the full rate for any Stable Booking
9. **Represented Cheques** – Any payment that has to be represented to the bank for whatever reason will be subject to a £15.00 administration fee for each occasion.
10. **Vehicles** – The Show Organiser reserves the right to remove any vehicle which is obstructing any access to or from the ground even if locked and unattended. The Show Organiser will not be liable for any injury, loss or damage occasioned by such removal.
11. **Dogs** – Dogs are permitted in the Lorry Park and car park only. They must be kept under control at all times. If, in the opinion of the Show Organiser, any person fails to control their dog/s they may be asked to leave the Showground.
12. **Prize Giving** – The Show organiser reserves the right to withhold prizes if competitors do not attend the Official Prize Giving.
13. **Objections** – Objection should be made in writing in accordance to BSJA Rule 198. Two Show Stewards will be appointed to the Show in accordance to Rule 96.2
14. **Official Photographs** – Any photographs taken at the Championship by the Official Photographer may be used by the Show Organiser for promotional purposes.
15. **First Aid** – A total of £4 per competitor per day or £12 for the show will be charged towards medical cover during the hours of competition.
16. **Vaccination Certificate** – All horses at the show must have a current and valid certificate of vaccination against Equine Influenza. There will be random checking of certificates and any horse found without a valid certificate will be asked to leave the show ground
17. **Stallions** – No person shall allow a stallion for which he/she is responsible as owner, lessee, authorized agent or rider to compete or be prepared to compete, in any class without taking adequate precautions to ensure other persons are not put at risk of injury.
18. **Close of Entries** – Entries will close on the official closing date. Should space be available late entries may be accepted..

Please read carefully the General Rules and Regulations. Any person coming to the show or involved in any aspect of the meeting is deemed bound by the General Rules & Regulations.
